  - d. Ground transportation from and to Eastern Iowa Airport (if applicable)
  - e. Photocopies at Hoover Library

3. **Research Proposal narrative:** Up to 1,200 words, plus a one-page bibliography.

- a. **Language:** Keep it clear and simple.
- b. **Abstract:** Clearly state the specific research topic in the first paragraph.
- c. **Objectives:** State the research objectives.
- d. **Literature:** State the relationship of the topic to current historical literature, and state how the proposed research will contribute to historical understanding of the topic.
- e. **Papers:** State which Hoover Library collections you propose to use.
- f. **Bibliography:** Include a selected, one page bibliography for this topic.

4. **Names of References who are sending letters:** List three persons familiar with your work who will provide information regarding your personal abilities and research potential. It is suggested, but not required, that letters come from more than one institution. Three letters of recommendation must be postmarked by March 1, 2010 and sent directly to the Hoover Library Association for the application package to be eligible for review.

It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure all letters have been sent. It is strongly suggested that the applicant contact the Hoover Library Association to verify that three letters have been received.
